Welcome to the Royal City Artistic Swimming Club Novice Competitive Stream!

PRACTICE SCHEDULE:

This program is a full-season commitment from September 2020 to May 2021. The 11-12 and 13-15 Novice Competitive program practices twice weekly on Thursday evenings at Victor Davis Pool and Saturday afternoons at the University of Guelph, Red Pool. The practice schedule is:

13 – 15 Team:	Thursdays	6:00 – 6:30pm (dryland) 6:30 – 8:00pm (pool)

Due to COVID19, our meet schedule will be very different. The Novice Competitive Swimmers will be competing in Dryland skills regionally based in-pool competitions. This means that they will learn a routine and will showcase it at competitions and at our water shows (virtual or in-person). More details on the draft competition schedule will be provided in October.

FEES:

Fees are based on registration and include mandatory Ontario Artistic Swimming and Canada Artistic Swimming registration pool rental, coaching, and general club operations. The 2020-21 fees are as follows:

11-12 Team: \$1900 including a \$250 initial registration fee due by September 11th (non-refundable)

13-15 Team: \$2000 including a \$250 initial registration fee due by September 11th (non-refundable)

Competition Suits (approx. \$75-\$100) and Competition Registration fees (approx. \$75-\$100) will be charged separately.

Payment schedule will be provided at the beginning of the season. Due to COVID19, we will be charging the fees over nine months (September – May). If programming is cancelled due to COVID19 and moves to online training only, fees will be adjusted to reflect the reduced training costs.

SWIM & TEAM APPAREL:

Athletic sport teams often have supplementary fees associated with team apparel and required uniforms. For your convenience, RCASC sells the required Novice Competitive team swimwear which includes one black one-piece swimsuit, team t-shirt, goggles, 2 swim caps (white and RCASC Cap), and nose plugs which are all necessary for the synchro season. These items cost approximately \$200. In addition, there will also be supplementary items available for purchase including team jacket, pants and swim bags.

FUNDRAISING:

All Novice Competitive Team participants are required to fundraise to support the club operations during the synchro season. At the initial parents meeting in September fundraising requirements will be outlined. Fundraising activities in previous years included selling MacMillan Cookie Dough, Paint Nights, and Vesey's Bulbs. Swimmers are also encouraged to seek corporate sponsorships for their fundraising requirements. **The fundraising requirement for each novice swimmer is \$350 for the season.**
